Players without conflicting Tournament events may elect to play organised Social Tennis. The Club tournament will take precedent over Social Tennis in court allocation. Matches will be played on grass courts.

Tournament matches will be scheduled to commence from 12:30 p.m but some matches might be earlier.

Please mark the events in which you wish to participate, with a maximum of 3 events per participant. Partners in doubles events should submit their own Entry Form. Note that you can only enter ONE DIVISION per event.

Division 1 (Championship) is aimed at the State Grade Players, but Social Grade 2 are eligible to compete. If you do not have a Social Grade, the entry is limited to UTR 5 (Men) or 5 (Women) or higher.

Division 2 entry is limited to Social Grade 2 and below. If you do not have a Social Grade, the entry is limited to UTR 4 (Men) or 4 (Women) or weaker.

Division 3 entry is limited to Social Grade 2B and below. If you do not have a Social Grade, the entry is limited to UTR 2 (Men) or (Women) 1

If you have both a Cottesloe Social Grade and a UTR, the Social Grade will determine entry qualifications.

INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

All members of Cottesloe Tennis Club are invited to play in the 2023 Club Tournament.

There will be events for players of all standards including Division 1 (*Championship*), Division 2 and Division 3. Organised Social Tennis will be held concurrently subject to the availability of courts.

Each Division will have the same 5 Events: Men and Ladies Singles, Men and Ladies Doubles and Mixed Doubles. Players may be required to play in more than one event in the same day, depending upon overall schedule constraints.

A prize-giving event will be held - details will be notified via Top Spin - for Club members, their family and friends.

General

- **Dates:** Events will be conducted over 2 weekends, relevant finals on each Sunday.
- **Entry Forms:** Please enter as early as possible for all events. Don't wait until last day! Must either be emailed to **champs.ctc@gmail.com**, or hand delivered to the Tournament Entry Box in the **slot** in front of the Club House to arrive no later than 6:00 p.m. on 18 March 2023.
- **Eligibility:** Qualifications for each Division are found on the Entry Form. Social Tennis players are each eligible for two Divisions - one at approximately their level, and one a level higher should they wish to challenge themselves at the higher level. Note that you can only play in ONE division in any event.
- **Check In:** Players are to report to the Tournament desk **15 minutes** prior to scheduled match time. Late arrivals may incur a forfeit.
- **Match times will be published** by the prior Thursday at 5:00 p.m. for the upcoming Saturday and Sunday matches to Tennis Australia **<https://tournaments.tennis.com.au> website – click on Cottesloe Tennis Club**. A link will also be made available via the CTC website once the events start. *NB: Tournament link will only become live by Thursday 23 March 2023 and then please check regularly.*
- **Social Play:** Organised social play will be held on both weekends, subject to court availability.
- **Contact Numbers:** Tournament organiser can be reached via *Jane Ward 0488010037*
- **Time of Play:** Events will be scheduled from 12:30 p.m. each day of play. Some flexibility with schedule times may be required. If there are delays or conflicts, players may self-arrange to play midweek **only if all players agree and the tournament schedule is not affected**. Any re-scheduled match (midweek) must be notified in advance to **champs.ctc@gmail.com**
- **Match Format:** For each Division, two tie-break sets plus Super Tie break (10 point) tie-break in lieu of a third set, if necessary. No umpires will be provided. Tennis West rules will apply. A round robin event may be played depending on numbers – will be at the tournament organiser discretion.
- **Event Restrictions:** Entry to only one Division per event will be permitted. Juniors under 15 will only be permitted with approval of the Committee. Entrants may participate in Social tennis if it does not conflict with scheduled tournament matches.
- **Disclaimer:** Events may be modified, combined or eliminated depending upon the number of participants at the discretion of the Captain's Committee. The Captain has the final decision in any disputes.
