The Club tournament will take precedent over Social Tennis in court allocation.

Tournament matches will be scheduled to commence from 12:30 p.m. Match day and times can be rearranged by players to provide flexibility as needed to maintain scheduling but must not cause conflicts for other players.

Please mark the events in which you wish to participate, with a maximum of 3 events per participant. Partners in doubles events should each submit their own Entry Form. Note that you can only enter ONE DIVISION per event.

Division 1 (Championship) is aimed at the State Grade Players, but Social Grade 2A and above are eligible to compete. If you do not have a Social Grade, the entry is limited to Tennis West CTR 4.0 (Men) or 4 (Women) or better.

Division 2 entry is limited to Social Grade 2 and below. If you do not have a Social Grade, the entry is limited to Tennis West CTR 3 (Men) or 3 (Women) or weaker.

Division 3 entry is limited to Social Grade 2B and below. If you do not have a Social Grade, the entry is limited to Tennis West CTR 7 (Men) or (Women) 7 or weaker (*NB: 8+ is weaker than 7*)

If you have both a Cottesloe Social Grade and a Tennis West CTR, the Social Grade will determine entry qualifications.

Entry forms preferably should be **emailed** (admin@cottesloetennis.com.au), but may be **posted** (PO Box 12, Cottesloe, W.A. 6911), or **hand delivered** to 'Tournament Entry Box' in the **slot** in front of the Club House to arrive by 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, 27 September (Division 1) or 11 October 2020.

INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

All members of Cottesloe Tennis Club are invited to play in the 2020 Club Tournament. There will be events for players of all standards including Division 1 (*Championship*), Division 2 and Division 3. Organised Social Tennis will be held concurrently subject to the availability of courts. All members are requested to comply with the Club's Phase 4 COVID_19 restrictions still in place in WA and exercise physical distancing and good hand hygiene at all times.

Division 2 & 3 will have the same 5 Events: Mens and Ladies Singles, Mens and Ladies Doubles and Mixed Doubles. Players may be required to play in more than one event in the same day, depending upon overall schedule constraints.

A prize-giving event, will be held on Opening Day 10 October for Division 1 Singles Champions and a Division 2 & 3 prize giving will be scheduled for Sunday November 1 2020.

General

- **Dates:** Events will be conducted over the stated two weekends with Championship singles finals on Opening Day. Given time of year, COVID-19 and pennants season, players will need to be flexible to have matches played before next rounds. If players are unavailable, match will be forfeited:
- **Entry Forms:** Can be downloaded from our CTC website and must be emailed to admin@cottesloetennis.com.au, posted to the club or hand delivered to the Tournament Entry Box in the **slot** in front of the Club House to arrive no later than 6:00 p.m. on the 27 September for Division 1 and all others by 11 October 2020.
- **Eligibility:** Qualifications for each Division are found on the Entry Form. Social Tennis players are each eligible for two Divisions - one at approximately their level, and one a level higher should they wish to challenge themselves at the higher level. Note that you can only play in ONE division in any event.
- **Check In:** Players are to report to the Tournament desk **15 minutes** prior to scheduled match time. Late arrivals may incur a forfeit. Match times will be posted by the prior Thursday at 6:00 p.m. for the upcoming Saturday and Sunday matches.
- **Social Play:** Organised social play will be held on both weekends, subject to court availability.
- **Contact Numbers:** The Tournament organisers can be reached at Liz 0405705751 or e.peterson@inet.net.au (include CTC in the subject line). Results to be reported by email asap following matches - if played during week.
- **Time of Play:** Events will be scheduled from 12:30 p.m. each day of play. Some flexibility with schedule times may be required due to court availability and pennant player availability.
- **Match Format:** For each Division, two tie-break sets plus Pro (10 point) tie-break in lieu of a third set, if necessary. No umpires will be provided. Tennis West rules will apply.
- **Plate Events or Round Robin:** Whether a plate event for 1st round losers or a round robin format is applied instead of the standard tournament will depend on entry numbers for Divisions 2 and 3 events. This does not apply to Division 1 but a minimum number of entries is required.
- **Event Restrictions:** Entry to only one Division per event will be permitted. Juniors under 15 will only be permitted with approval of the Committee. Entrants may participate in Social tennis if it does not conflict with scheduled tournament matches.
- **Disclaimer:** Events may be modified, combined or eliminated depending upon the number of participants at the discretion of the Captain's Committee. The Captain has the final decision in any disputes.
