ORGANIZED SOCIAL PLAY

We offer several opportunities for organised social tennis at Cottesloe Tennis Club. It is free for members and visitors are very welcome:

- Tuesday and Wednesday mornings:
9am – 11am (9:30am – 11.30am in winter)
- Saturday and Sunday afternoons:
2pm – 5:30pm (1:30pm – 5.00pm start in winter)

Visitor fees are \$20 for weekends and \$15 for midweek social tennis.

On arrival, all players should check in with the set organiser at the front window to sign up. There are breaks for morning and afternoon tea/coffee, and all are invited to stay for a drink when the bar opens at 5pm on weekends.

Tennis for Juniors

COURT PLAY – BOOKING AND HIRE

Hard Court play by Members

Members playing on the hard courts, day or night, should use the online system 'Book a Court' to reserve them and to control the lights. For more information see www.cottesloetennis.com.au/play-tennis/court-hire/. Members do not have to pay for lights to play on the hard courts at night.

Grass and Hard-Court Hire by Non-Members

Courts are available for hire by non-members if not needed for organized social play, coaching or league competition. The decision to hire courts during social play times is at the discretion of the Sets Desk Operator or Duty Captain. Court hire on certain evenings in the summer can be limited due to league competitions.

Court hire fees are \$20 per hour for hard and grass courts at all times.

Members bringing visitors to the Club for other than organized social play are responsible for paying the court hire for their visitors. The fees payable are:

If playing singles: \$10.00 per hour

If playing doubles: \$5.00 each non-member per hour

Court hire fees for grass courts are to be placed in a plastic container provided and inserted in the chute located under the windows on the east side of the clubhouse.

| Membership Category | Annual Fees (A\$ incl. GST) | Entitlements |

| Full | 570 | Access to all available courts all week, including weekends |
| Mid-Week | 460 | Access to all available courts Monday – Friday. Able to attend weekday and weekend social functions |
| Family (Parents + children ≤ 18) | 1,340 | Parents receive Full memberships and dependent children aged 18 and younger receive Junior memberships |
| Junior (aged ≤ 18) | 220 | As Full membership |
| Full-time Student (aged ≤ 25) | 225 | As Full membership. Proof of Full-time student status required |
| Young adult (aged 19-25) | 280 | As Full membership |
| Social (non-playing) | 50 | Entitled to all social events and general socializing at the club but no free access to courts. |

Note: Lights for play on the hard courts at night is free of charge for playing members

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Annual membership commences 1st October.
- Temporary membership is available for visitors to Perth.
- Grass courts are closed for play every Monday except public holidays. During the summer, some grass courts may be available on Mondays at the discretion of the groundskeeper.
- Members may not arrange their own sets during organized social play.
- All players are required to wear neat tennis clothing, including tennis shoes that do not mark or harm the courts. Pimple-soled shoes are not allowed on the grass courts. Players who are not properly attired may be refused play on the courts.
- Club balls are provided for organized social play only.
