Full Membership	570	No restriction when courts are available
Mid-week Membership	460	Except weekends. Able to attend weekday and weekend social functions
Family Membership (Parents + children <18)	1,340	At all times for parents. Junior family members as per junior membership
Junior Membership ≤ 18	220	Except during designated adult play times
Full-time Student ≤ 25	320	No restriction when courts are available
Young adult (19-25)	320	No restriction when courts are available
Social (non-playing)	50	Organised social events and general socializing but no free access to courts.

Organised Social Play

Social play for **adults**:

Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 9.00am – 11am (9:30am-11:30am in winter)
Saturdays and Sundays from 2.00 pm to close of play in summer (from 1.30pm in winter)

Visitors are invited to join in organised social play (maximum of four times) and to socialise at the bar afterwards.

Visitor fees: Weekend \$20.00; Mid-week: \$15.00.

For any Junior Club enquiries please contact Rick Bretnall at juniors@cottesloetennis.com.au. On Saturday and Sunday mornings, Junior Members and group coaching have court usage priority. Junior Members must relinquish courts to senior members, if required, after 4.30pm on weekdays.

League Competition

The Club has many junior and senior teams in the Tennis West summer and winter League Competitions. Members wishing to be considered for selection should contact the Club Captain or Pennant Supervisor. All League Competition team members must be financial members of the Club.

Social Activities

Members are welcome to stay for a drink at the bar after tennis on the weekends and on certain weekdays. Tea and coffee are available after tennis during the week. Visitors are welcome as guests of members. No Member may bring more than five guests at a time.

During the year the Club organises several social functions and, during the summer months, twilight and bbq events. Dates are advertised during the year via email, the Club notice board and the Club website

Court Hire

Courts are available for hire by non-members if not needed for organized social play, coaching or league competition. The decision to hire courts during social play is at the discretion of the Sets Desk Operator or Duty Captain. Court hire on certain evenings in the summer can be limited due to league competitions.

Court hire fees are \$20 per hour for hard and grass courts at all times.

Members bringing visitors to the Club for other than organised social play are responsible for paying the court hire for their visitors. The fees payable are:

- If playing singles: \$10.00 per hour
- If playing doubles: \$5.00 each non-member per hour

Court hire fees are to be placed in a plastic container provided and inserted in the chute located near the windows on the east side of the clubhouse

Please note.....

- Annual membership commences 1st October.
- Temporary membership is available for overseas and interstate visitors only.
- Members who remain unfinancial after October 31 will be suspended from play until outstanding fees are paid and are ineligible to play in Tennis West League matches
- Grass courts are closed for play every Monday except public holidays. During the summer, grass courts 21-25 may be available at the discretion of the groundskeeper.
- Members may not arrange their own sets during organised social play.
- All players are required to wear neat tennis clothing, including tennis shoes that do not mark or harm the courts. Pimple-soled shoes are not allowed on the grass courts. Players who are not properly attired may be refused play on the courts.
- Club balls are provided for organised social play only.
