Organized Social Play

Social play for **adults**:

Tuesdays from 9.00am – 11am (9:30am – 11:30am in winter)

Saturdays and Sundays from 2.00 pm – 5:30pm (1.30pm – 5pm in winter)

Visitors are invited to join organized social play and to socialize at the bar afterwards. These sessions are free for visitors up to three times before joining. *Please note that a minimum standard of play is required to join into social play. If the Captain or Midweek Director determines that you do not meet the minimum standard, you will be asked to get coaching and more practice before re-joining social play.*

For Junior Club enquiries please contact Rick Bretnall at juniors@cottesloetennis.com.au. On Saturday and Sunday mornings, Junior Members and group coaching have priority for court use. Junior Members must relinquish courts to adult members, if required, after 5pm on weekdays.

League Competition

The Club has many junior and adult teams in the Tennis West summer and winter League Competitions, commonly called 'Pennants'. Junior members wishing play pennants should contact the Club Coach at admin@tennisapproach.com.au. For adult pennants contact our pennant supervisors at pennants@cottesloetennis.com.au. All members of pennants teams must be financial members of the Club.

Social Activities

Members are welcome to stay for a drink at the bar after tennis on the weekends and on some weekdays. Tea and coffee are available after tennis during the week. Visitors are welcome as guests of members. No Member may bring more than five guests at a time.

Hard Court play by Members

Members playing on the hard courts, day or night, should use the online system 'Book a Court' to reserve them and to control the lights. For more information see www.cottesloetennis.com.au/play-tennis/court-hire/. Members do not have to pay for lights to play on the hard courts at night.

Members playing with visitors are responsible for paying the court hire for their visitors. The fee is \$10 per hour for up to 3 visitors per court. Pay using the Book a Court system, for both hard and grass courts.

Grass and Hard-Court Hire by Non-Members

Courts are available for hire by non-members when not needed for organized social play, coaching or league competition. The decision to hire courts during social play times is at the discretion of the Sets Desk Operator or Duty Captain. Court hire on certain evenings in the summer can be limited due to league competitions.

Court hire fees are \$25 per hour for hard and grass courts during the day, \$30 per hour after 6:00 pm.

Other information

- Annual membership commences 1st October.
- Temporary membership is available for visitors to Perth.
- Grass courts are closed for play every Monday except public holidays. During the summer, some grass courts may be available on Mondays at the discretion of the groundskeeper.
- Members may not arrange their own sets during organized social play unless authorized by the Duty Captain.
- All players are required to wear neat tennis clothing, including tennis shoes that do not mark or harm the courts. Pimple-soled shoes are not allowed on the grass courts.
- Club balls are provided for organized social play only.
