Cottesloe Tennis Club Policy on Dogs at the Club March 2024

Purpose of this Policy

Club Members and Visitors from time to time bring their dogs to the Club. This has the potential to cause concern, and possible injury, to other Members and guests. This policy provides guidance regarding dogs at the Club.

Dog Policy

Dogs on the Club grounds must be kept on a leash at all times, either tied to a solid fixture or under the direct control of a responsible adult. This leash must be short enough and visible enough to avoid creating a tripping hazard.

If the dog is tied to a solid fixture, it should be away from high traffic areas so that other Club visitors can avoid getting near the dog if they wish.

At no time are dogs allowed in the children's playground or on tennis courts.

Club officials retain the right to request the removal of any dog at any time.

This Policy is consistent with the 'WA Dog Act 1976' and the Cottesloe 'Dogs Local Law 2011'.
